The Fairgrounds Nashville will remain closed to events through May

NASHVILLE- The Fairgrounds Nashville continues to closely monitor guidelines for reopening events and facilities through both Tennessee Governor Bill Lee's and Nashville Mayor John Cooper's offices. Given the staging guidance recently released, the May Flea Market and other events scheduled for this month at the Fairgrounds will not be held.

"As always, our first concern is for the health and safety of our employees, vendors, and visitors. We are as eager as anyone to once again hold events and look forward to fully reopening Fairgrounds facilities when we get the green light from local and state officials to host large groups," said Laura Womack, Fairgrounds executive director.

Fairgrounds staff will continue to support the homeless shelter for as long as it is needed and thanks the many Metro departments and partners that have contributed to its operation.
